Dawn Madahbee Leach is a proud member of the Aundeck Omni Kaning First Nation on Manitoulin Island in Ontario where she has served as a member of her community’s elected Council. Since 1988, she has been General Manager of the Waubetek Business Development Corporation, an Indigenous Financial Institution that provides financing and economic services to Indigenous entrepreneurs and First Nation communities throughout Northeast Ontario. Under her leadership, Waubetek has proudly invested more than \$160 million in nearly 4,000 Aboriginal businesses who experience a business success rate of 94%. Ms. Madahbee Leach studied at York University and Laurentian University where she earned a degree in Political Science with a minor in Law.

Dawn shares her knowledge and expertise on various Boards and committees including the National Indigenous Economic Development Board where she currently serves as Chair. She also serves on the Boards of the Peace Hills Trust Company, NioBay Minerals Inc., TC Energy, the Des Nedhe Group of Companies, and the Indigenous Centre of Excellence for Mineral Development. She worked alongside National Indigenous Organizations to develop the 2022 National Indigenous Economic Strategy for Canada, the first national strategy of its kind penned exclusively by Indigenous People.

Dawn’s work has been acknowledged by the Canadian Council for Aboriginal Business who honoured her with the 2023 Business Lifetime Achievement Award. She also received the 2020 INDSPiRE Award in the Business and Commerce Category and was celebrated as one of Canada’s 100 Most Powerful Women by the Women’s Executive Network in 2018. EAGLE STAFF
LE BÂTON À EXPLOITS (AIGLE)

The Eagle Staff is a sacred symbol in First Nation culture and also serves as a territorial demarcation symbol of the area and homeland for First Nations. The Laurentian University Eagle Staff is made from diamond willow, copper and grandfather stones signifying honesty and representing the achievements, integrity, and honor of our community. This powerful staff reflects strength, freedom, and spiritual guidance connecting us to the Creator. In ceremony, it embodies community prayers and aspirations, serving as a reminder of the bond between the community, the Creator and nature. In Anishinaabe culture, the Eagle Staff also signifies various spiritual entities and healing practices and is a revered symbol of cultural tradition and community identity. As part of Anishinaabe protocol, the Eagle Staff is usually present to formalize significant events.

Un bâton à exploits est un symbole sacré dans la culture des Premières Nations et sert également de symbole de délimitation territoriale de leur région et de leur patrie. Le bâton à exploits (aigle) de l’Université Laurentienne est fait de saule à motif de diamant, de cuivre et de pierres des grands-pères signifiant l’honnêteté et représentant les réalisations, l’intégrité et l’honneur de notre communauté. Ce bâton puissant exprime la force, la liberté et l’encadrement spirituel qui nous relie au Créateur. Lors des cérémonies, il incarne les prières et les aspirations de la communauté, rappelant le rapprochement entre la communauté, le Créateur et la nature. Dans la culture anishinaabe, le bâton à exploits représente également diverses entités spirituelles et pratiques de guérison et est un symbole vénéré de la tradition culturelle et de l’identité communautaire. Selon le protocole anishinaabe, le bâton à exploits a généralement une présence pour officialiser les événements importants.

THE MACE

LA MASSE

The Mace is a symbol of authority and guidance. It is shouldered by the Macebearer who, clothed in a specially designed gown, leads the procession of graduands, faculty, members of the Board of Governors, special guests, the Chancellor, and the President and Vice-Chancellor, into the auditorium to participate in the Convocation ceremony. When the entire procession has entered, the Mace is placed on a designated pedestal before the Chancellor, at the front of the stage. It remains there until the closure of the Convocation ceremony, at which time it is borne again by the Macebearer who leads the Convocation procession out of the auditorium.

Laurentian's Mace was designed by Dora de Pedery-Hunt. It was crafted from Sudbury metals – copper and nickel – and adorned with golden studs, representing strength and power. The University's crest is engraved at the tip of the shaft. This gift from The Imperial Order Daughters of the Empire (IODE), Elizabeth Fry Chapter, was presented to the University at their annual dinner on May 17, 1966.

La Masse est un symbole d'autorité et de gouverne. Elle est portée par le massier qui, revêtu d'une toge spécialement conçue, mène à l'intérieur de l'auditorium le cortège formé des diplômés, du corps professoral, des membres du Conseil des gouverneurs, des invités spéciaux, du chancelier et du recteur et vice-chancelier pour participer à la cérémonie de la collation des grades. Lorsque le cortège entier a fait son entrée, la Masse est déposée à l'avant de la scène, devant le chancelier, sur un socle destiné à cet effet. Elle y demeure jusqu'à la fin de la cérémonie, moment auquel le massier la reprend pour conduire le cortège à l'extérieur de l'auditorium.

La Masse de l'Université Laurentienne est l'oeuvre de Dora de Pedery-Hunt. Elle a été confectionnée à partir de métaux trouvés dans la région de Sudbury – le cuivre et le nickel – et ornée de cloutages dorés qui représentent la force et le pouvoir. L'écusson de l'Université est gravé au bout du manche de la Masse. Ce cadeau de l'Ordre impérial des filles de l'Empire, section Elizabeth Fry, a été présenté à l'Université lors du banquet annuel de l'Ordre tenu le 17 mai 1966.
