

The Donna L. Williams Memorial Environmental Scholarship

Please note the Student Awards Office is now accepting application letters for the Donna Williams Memorial Environmental Scholarship. The deadline is May 31.

The purpose of this award is to support a full-time student who has completed a minimum of 24 credits in one academic year while enrolled in a Bachelor of Arts in Environmental Studies at Laurentian University, in English or French. The successful recipient will demonstrate strong academic standing (B+ overall average or higher) while successfully completing at least 12 ENVI credits during the year including credits required from cognate disciplines counting toward program credit. The successful recipient will also demonstrate commitment to the environment and community through extracurricular volunteering and/or relationship building or participation in Laurentian University's School of the Environment or General Student Association committee work. Preference will be given to a female student or a student who identifies as being female, and who demonstrates the use of artistic means (i. e. sculpture, textile arts, jewelry making, music, writing, dance, etc.). Value is \$1,000. Application is required (a letter expressing interest in the award and especially a commitment to the environment). The successful recipient will be chosen by the Director of the School of the Environment in consultation with the Student Awards Office.
